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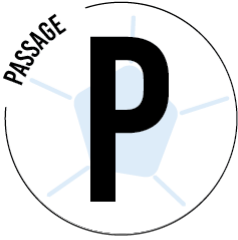
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LESSON BREAKDOWN

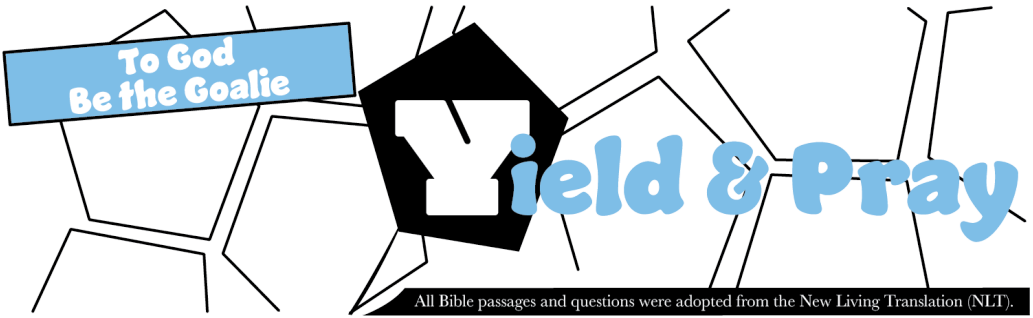
There is a cost for not following the watchman.
