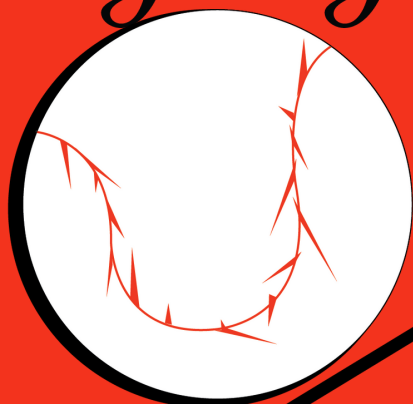

Read and study a Bible passage or story related to the chapter topic. What stuck out to you?



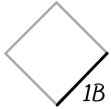
Breakdown the lessons from the Bible passage or story. What truth did you learn?



How can you apply the Bible passage or story to your sport and your life?



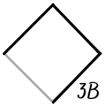
Respond to the Bible passage or story in prayer. What do you need to yield to God?



Read Ephesians 6:10-20



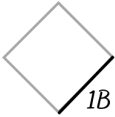
Summarize, in your own words, what this passage of Scripture is about.

HITTING FOR THE CYCLE: How can you relate this passage to your baseball gear?



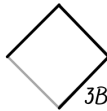
Put on God's armor to resist the devil.

Read **Hebrews 4:12-13**...What are we reminded of here? How can you relate this to your baseball equipment?

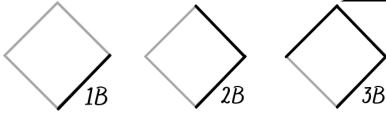


HITTING FOR THE CYCLE: Reflect on and write down other lessons you learned from Ephesians and the other passages related to your baseball equipment.

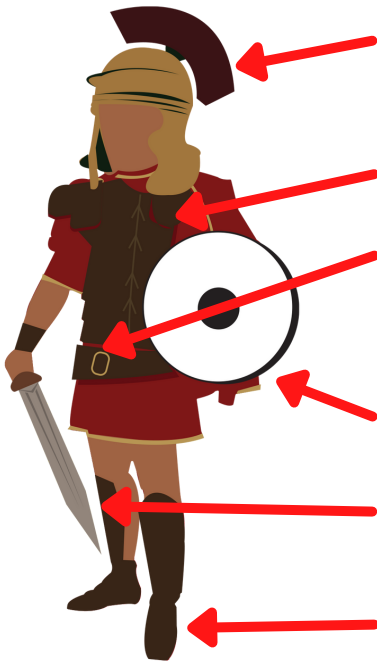
Application
